Public holidays are important as these days have significance in the history of a nation. On April 1st 1955, EOKA, whose aim was unification with Greece, started a guerilla campaign against the British. This lasted for the next four years and on August 16th 1960, a cease-fire was reached and Cyprus attained its independence.

The day is marked by closed shops and businesses as well as a military parade in the capital, Nicosia.
