### **PENTECOST / KATAKLYSMOS**

The Greek word Kataklysmos means cataclysm (flood). This year, the festival is celebrated the weekend that leads to Monday, June 5<sup>th</sup>. Kataklysmos, is a unique Cypriot festival, and one of the most popular annual celebrations in Cyprus. This celebration is usually held in seaside towns and activities include games, folk dancing, boat races, swimming competitions, feasting and listening to Cyprus traditional songs "tsiattista". The most popular custom is throwing water at each other, in memory of the flood that once destroyed nearly all life on earth.
