From humble beginnings, as the son of a café owner and a midwife, Mr Saveriades embarked on a remarkable journey that led him to England at the young age of 14. Upon returning to Cyprus in the late 1950s, Mr. Saveriades embarked on a journey that would shape the region's education landscape. At just 23 years old, he founded his private high school in Famagusta, laying the foundation for his lifelong dedication to empowering young minds. Despite the turmoil of the 1974 Turkish invasion, Mr. Saveriades displayed unparalleled resilience, rebuilding his educational organisation and championing the cause of education for all, regardless of circumstance.

In 1997, Casa College was established by Mr. Saveriades to provide tertiary education to local students. He also welcomed many international students from different countries. Mr. Saveriades worked hard to keep Casa College ahead of the curve in education by forming partnerships and agreements with prestigious universities. He ensured the college offered various disciplines to meet the world's changing demands. His tireless efforts to support refugees, advocacy for the less fortunate, and love for animals testify to his compassionate heart and unwavering dedication to making a difference in the world.
